

## **MINISTERING GIFTS of the SPIRIT**

"Follow after charity and desire spiritual gifts...;

...seek that ye may excel to the edifying of the church." {1 Corinthians 14:1,12}

<u>3 Gifts of Revelation</u> (gifts that reveal something)

the word of wisdom the word of knowledge discerning of spirits

3 Gifts of Power

(gifts that do something)

the gift of faith working of miracles the gift of healing

**3 Gifts of Inspiration** (gifts that say something)

the gift of prophecy divers kind of tongues interpretation of tongues



Gifts given unto men (5 fold ministry) {Ephesians 4:7,8,11; Psalms 68:18; 1 Corinthians 12:28}

"But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ. Wherefore he saith, When he ascended upon high, he led captivity captive, and gave gifts unto men."

1. apostles = governs  $\{652\}$  apostolos (ap-os-tol-os) Gr. -

a delegate; an ambassador of the gospel; he that is sent; offically a commissioner of Christ with miraculous powers

2. **prophets** = guides {4396} prophetes (prof-ay-tace) Gr. - an inspired speaker

3. **evangelists** = gathers {2099} <u>euaggelistes</u> (yoo-ang-ghel-is-tace) Gr. -

a preacher of the gospel; to announce good news

Gifts of the Spirit

4. pastors = guards {4166} poimen (poy-mane) Gr. - a shepherd

5. **teachers** = grounds {1320} didaskalos (did-as-kal-os) Gr. - an instructor

<u>miracles</u> {1411}<u>dunamics</u> (doo-nam-is) Gr. -

miraculous powers; ability; worker of miracles

<u>healings</u> {2386} <u>iama</u> (ee-am-ah) Gr. -

a cure, the effect, healing

<u>helps</u> {484} <u>antilepsis</u> (an-til-ape-sis) Gr. -

relief, to participate

governments {2941} <u>kubernesis</u> (koo-ber-nay-sis) Gr. -

to steer, directorship (in the church)

tongues {1100} glossa (glocc-sah) Gr. -

the tongue; a language (specifically one naturally acquired)

[ read - Numbers 8:19; 18:6,7]

"A man's gift maketh room for him, and bringeth him before great men." {Proverbs 18:16}

[ read - Romans 12:4-8] "Neglect not the gift that is within thee, which was given thee by prophecy..." [1 Timothy 4:14]

The Gift of God is...

...eternal life through Jesus Christ. {John 3:16; Romans 6:23}
...salvation by grace through faith. {Ephesians 2:8}
receiving the Holy Chost

...receiving the Holy Ghost. {Acts 2:38; 11:17} ...for every man to rejoice in his labour. {Ecclesiastes 5:19}

Fruit of the Spirit is... {Galatians 5:22,23}

...Love, Goodness, Joy, Faith, Peace, Meekness, Longsuffering, Temperance, Gentleness

Against such, there is no law; And the servant of the Lord must not strive. {2 Timothy 2:24,25}

- -- Be gentle unto all men
- -- Apt to teach
- -- Patient
- -- In meekness, instructing those that oppose themselves

And beside this (the gift and promises of God), giving all diligence,

ADD to Your... {2 Peter 1:5-9}

...faith - virtue ...virtue - knowledge ...knowledge - temperance ...temperance - patience

...patience - godliness ...godliness - brotherly kindness

...brotherly kindness - charity

For if "these things" be in you, and abound, they make you that ye shall neither be barron nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ.

But he that "lacketh these things" is blind, and cannot see afar off, and hath forgotten that he was purged from his old sins.

I beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

- : with all lowliness and meekness
- : with longsuffering
- : forbearing one another in love
- : endeavouring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace. {Ephesians 4:1-3}

For the "gifts" and "calling" of God are without repentance. {Romans 11:29; Acts 9:10-20}


To be **effective** in the "gifts" and "calling" of God, one **must**...

meet the plan of salvation	(John 3; Romans 10; 1 John 1)
sanctify self daily	(Luke 9:23; John 13:34,35; 2 Corinthians 6:14-18;
	2 Corinthians 7:1; 1 Peter 2:2; 2 Timothy 2:15)
have a spirit of forgiveness	(Matthew 6; Ephesians 4:32)
be filled with the Holy Ghost	(Acts 1-2)
make calling and election sure	(2 Peter 1)
	sanctify self daily  have a spirit of forgiveness be filled with the Holy Ghost

**Question:** Why must all of these things need be done? <u>read</u> - [Romans 12:1,2; Ephesians 4:12-14]

<u>Answer:</u> <u>It is your reasonable service</u>, that <u>ye may prove</u> what is that <u>good</u>, and <u>acceptable</u>, and <u>perfect</u> will of God. For the *perfecting of the saints*,...

"Whoso boasteth himself of a false gift is like clouds and wind without rain." {Proverbs 25:14; Jude 4,12,13}
