### Defined: Holy [Hebrew 6944] gôdesh (ko.-desh) – a sacred place or thing; sanctity: consecrated, dedicated, hallowed, holiness, saint, sanctuary [Hebrew 1478] g > va' (gaw-vah) – to breathe out, i.e. (by implication) expire: die, be dead, give Ghost up the ghost, perish [Genesis 25:8,17; 35:29; 49:33; Job 3:11; 10:18; 13:19; 14:10; Lamentations 1:19] [Greek 4151] pSeuma (pnyoo.-mah) – a curent of air, i.e. breath (blast) or a breeze; by analogy or figuratively a spirit, i.e. (human) the rational soul, (by implication) vital principle, mental disposition, etc or (superhuman) an angel, demons, or divine) God, Christ's spirit, the Holy Spirit; ghost, life, spirit (-ual, -ually), mind [Matthew 1:18,20; 3:11; 12:31-32; 27:50; 28:19; Mark 1:8; 3:28-29; 12:36; 13:11; Luke 1:15,35,41,67; 2:25-26; 3:16-22; 4:1; 12:10,12] **spirit** {Spirit} [Hebrew 7307] rowach (roo.-akh) – wind; by resemblance breath, i.e. a sensible (or even violent) exhalation; figuratively life, anger, unsubstantiality; by extension a region of the sky; by resemblance spirit, but only of a rational being (include its expression & function): air, anger, blast, breath, cool, courage, mind, spirit (-ual), temptest [Genesis 1:2; 6:3; 41:38; Exodus 28:3; 31:3; 35:31; Numbers 11:17,25-26; 14:24; 24:2; Deuteronomy 34:9; Judges 3:10; 6:34; 11:29; 13:25; 14:6,19; 15:14; 1 Samuel 10:5-7,10; 11:6; 16:13-14; 19:20-24; 2 Samuel 23:2; 2 Kings 2:9,15 1 Chronicles 2:18; 28:12; 2 Chronicles 15:1; 20:14; 24:20]

### The Holy Ghost is the *promise* & *gift* of God the Father Almighty.

[read - Joel 3; Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-5,8; 2:38-39]

Isaiah 44:1-6 "...I will **pour my spirit upon** thy seed, and my blessing upon thine offspring..."

<u>Matthew 3:11</u> "...he shall **baptize** you with the **Holy Ghost** <u>and with fire</u>." (Mark 1:8; Luke 3:15-16; John 1:33)

Read: the Spirit of God, the Holy Ghost descending on Jesus [Matthew 3:16-17; Mark 1:9-13; Luke 3:21-23; John 1:32-34]

<u>Matthew 12:31-32</u> "...but the blasphemy against the **Holy Ghost** <u>shall not be forgiven unto men</u>...but whosoever speaketh against the Holy Ghost, it shall not be forgiven him, neither in this world, neither in the world to come." [Mark 3:28-29; Luke 12:10]

"...<u>He that believeth on me</u>, as the scripture hath saith, <u>out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water</u>. <u>But this</u> <u>spake he of the **Spirit**</u>, which they that believe on him should receive: for **the Holy Ghost was not yet given**: because that Jesus was not yet glorified." [John 7:37-39]

"But the **Comforter**, <u>which is</u> the **Holy Ghost**, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you." [John 14:26] (Luke 12:12; Acts 9:31)

"...after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen...wait for the promise of the Father,...For John truly baptized with water, but ye shall be <u>baptized with the Holy Ghost</u> not many days hence. But ye shall receive power, after that the <u>Holy Ghost is come upon you</u>..." [Acts1:2, 4-5,8]

"Then Peter said unto them, **Repent, and be baptized** everyone of you **in the name of Jesus Christ** for the remission of sins, and **ye shall receive** <u>the gift of the Holy Ghost</u>. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, even as many as the Lord shall call." [Acts 2:38-39] (see Ephesians 1:13-14)

**Day of Pentecost** – What happened???

[Acts 2]

- Tarrying in Jerusaleum, prayer & supplications, all on one accord in one place, v.1
- Suddenly, rushing mighty wind from heaven filled all the house, v.2
- > Appearance of cloven (divided) tongues like as of fire sat upon each of them, v.3
- They were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they began to speak with other tongues (not unknown tongues), as the spirit gave them utterance (no man taught them other tongues/languages how to speak), v.4
- > Jews dwelling at Jerusalem out of every nation under heaven, v.5
- Multitude of Jews confounded because every man heard them (Galil@ans) speak in his (Jews) own tongue/language wherein they (Jews) were born, v.6-8
- Nations of tongues (different languages of people) were amazed wondering what this meaneth (Galil@ans speaking Jews language of birth), v.9-12
- Apostle Peter stood up with the eleven and said, "Be this known unto you,...This is that which was spoken by the Prophet Joel (Joel 3), And it shall come to pass in the <u>last days</u>, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh...," v.14-21

"Jesus being by the right hand of God exalted and having <u>received of the Father</u> **the promise of the Holy Ghost**, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear." [Acts 2:32-33]

"...Simeon;...just and devout...and **the Holy Ghost was upon him**. And it was revealed unto him by the Holy Ghost that he should not see death, before he had seen the Lord's Christ." [Luke 2:25-26]

Again, the Holy Ghost is a gift for the believer to receive; some people try to make it difficult for you to receive. *Tarrying* (meaning to wait) *for the Holy Ghost*, is not scripture, except for where and when Jesus told his disciples (apostles) to tarry in Jerusalem (Luke 24:49); furthermore, **one must receive or be filled with the Holy Ghost** in order to be **more effective witnessing** and to be **more effective in the ministry** of Jesus Christ, even as the Father hath sent Him (Acts 1).

What is... "speaking in tongues"? other tongues *z* unknown tongue (there is a difference)

"In the law it is written, with <u>men</u> of <u>other tongues</u> and <u>other lips</u> <u>will I speak unto the people</u>; and for all that will they not hear me, saith the Lord. Wherefore <u>tongues are for a sign</u>, not to them that believe, but <u>to them that believe not</u>: but prophesying serveth not for them that believe not, but for them which believe..."

[1 Corinthians 14:21-33]

"...except ye utter by the tongue words easy to be understood, how shall it be known what is spoken? For ye shall speak into the air. There are, it may be, so many kind of voices in the world, and none of them is without signification." [1 Corinthians 14:7-10]

Defined:

tongue(s) [Hebrew 3956] <u>I>sh⊥wn</u>, <u>I>sh⊥n</u> (law-shone') {femine} <u>lesh⊥n>h</u> (lesh-o-naw') – the tongue (of man or animals), used literally (as the instrument of licking, eating, speech) and figuratively (speech, an ingot, a fork of flame, a cove of water, babbler, evil speaker, language, talker, tongue, wedge

"He that speaketh in an <u>unknown tongue</u> <u>edifieth himself</u>; but he that **prophesieth** edifieth the church. I would that ye all spake with tongues, but rather that ye prophesied:

for **greater is he that prophesieth** than he that <u>speaketh with tongues</u>, except he interpret, that the church may receive edifying." [1 Corinthians 14:4-5]

"Wherefore, let him that speaketh in an <u>unknown tongue</u> pray that he may interpret. For if I pray in an **unknown tongue**, <u>my spirit prayeth</u>, but <u>my understanding is unfruitful</u>." [1 Corinthians 14:13-14]

> "...for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the <u>Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings</u>..." [Romans 8:26-28]

> > How to receive the Holy Ghost

<u>Matthew 6:33</u> "Seek ye first the kingdom of God and his rightesousness..." <u>John 7:37</u> Jesus said, "If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. "...and so is the Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that obey him. [Acts 5:29-32](Romans 5:1-5)

"For God hath not given us a spirit of fear, but of **powe**r, and of **love**, and of a **sound mind**." [2 Timothy 1:7]

"Know ye not that <u>ve are the temple of God</u>, and that <u>the Spirit of God dwelleth in you</u>? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for <u>the temple of God is holy</u>, which temple ye are. What? Know ye not that <u>your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you</u>, which ye have of God, and **ye are not your own**?

For ye are bought with a price: therefore <u>glorify God in your body</u>, and <u>in your spirit</u>, which are God's." [1 Corinthians 3:16-17; 6:19-20]
