- j) Pray for neighbors on your street (community).
- k) Pray for those who speak against you or persecute you. [Matthew 5:44]
- 1) Pray for brothers and sisters in Christ who are without religious freedom.
- m) Pray for nations that prohibits the Gospel.
- n) Pray for those of false doctrine and not of Christ.
- o) Pray that our vision and borders may be enlarged.
- p) Pray for all the nations of the world.
