A PRAYER of PSALMS

{Repentance, Deliverance & Guidance}

5:1-4.8 Give ear to my words, O LORD, consider my meditation. Hearken unto the voice of my cry, my King, and my God: for unto thee will I pray.

My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up.

For thou art not a God that hath pleasure in wickedness: neither shall evil dwell with thee. Lead me, O LORD, in thy righteousness because of mine enemies; make thy way straight before my face.

Have mercy upon me, O LORD; for I am weak: O LORD, heal me; for my bones are vexed. 6:2-4 My soul is also sore vexed: but thou, O LORD, how long? Return, O LORD, deliver my soul: oh save me for thy mercies' sake.

Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude 51 of thy tender mercies blot out my transgressions.

Wash me throughly from mine iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions: and my sin is ever before me.

Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done this evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, and be clear when thou judgest.

Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean: wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow. Hide thy face from my sins, and blot out all mine iniquities.

Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me. Cast me not away from thy presence; and take not thy Holy Spirit from me. **Restore unto me** the joy of thy salvation; and uphold me with thy free spirit.

O LORD my God, in thee do I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and 7:1 deliver me:

Have mercy upon me, O LORD; consider my trouble which I suffer of them that hate me, 9:13 thou that liftest me up from the gates of death:

10:1,12 Why standest thou afar off, O LORD? Why hidest thou thyself in times of trouble? Arise, O LORD; O God, lift up thine hand: forget not the humble.

<u>12:1-2</u> Help, LORD; for the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men. They speak vanity every one with his neighbour: with flattering lips and with a double heart do they speak.

13:1-5 How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? forever? How long wilt thou hide thy face from me? How long shall I take counsel in my soul, having sorrow in my heart daily? How long shall mine enemy be exalted over me?

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Consider and hear me, O LORD my God: lighten mine eyes, lest I sleep the sleep of death; Lest mine enemy say, I have prevailed against him; and those that troubled me rejoice when I am moved. But I have trusted in thy mercy; my heart shall rejoice in thy salvation.

<u>16:1</u> Preserve me, O God: for in thee do I put my trust.

<u>17:1-2,5-9</u> Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, that goeth not out of feigned lips. Let my sentence come forth from thy presence; let thine eyes behold the things that are equal. Hold up my goings in thy paths, that my footsteps slip not. I have called upon thee, for thou wilt hear me, O God: incline thine ear unto me, and hear my speech.

Shew thy marvellous lovingkindness, O thou that savest by thy right hand them which put their trust in thee from those that rise up against them. Keep me as the apple of the eye, hide me under the shadow of thy wings, from the wicked that oppress me, from my deadly enemies, who compass me about.

20:9 Save, LORD: let the king hear us when we call.

<u>22:1-6,11</u> My God, my god, why hast thou forsaken me? Why art thou so far from helping me, and from the words of my roaring? O my God, I cry in the daytime, but thou hearest not; and in the night season, and am not silent. But thou art holy, O thou that inhabitest the praises of Israel.

Our fathers trusted in thee: they trusted, and thou didst deliver did. They cried unto thee, and were delivered: they trusted in thee, and were not confounded. But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach of men, and despised of the people. Be not far from me; for trouble is near; for there is none to help.

25:4-7.11 Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths. Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. Remember, O LORD, thy tender mercies and thy lovingkindness; for they have been ever of old. Remember not the sins of my youth, nor my transgressions: according to thy mercy remember thou me for thy goodness's sake, O LORD. For thy name's sake O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it is great.

<u>27:7.9.11-12</u> Hear, O LORD, when I cry with my voice: have mercy also upon me, and answer me. Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies. Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

<u>28:2</u> Hear the voice of my supplications, when I cry unto thee, when I lift up my hands toward thy holy oracle.

<u>35:1.4</u> Plead my cause, O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me. Let them be confounded and put to shame that seek after my soul let them be turned back and brought to confusion that devise my hurt.

38:21-22 Forsake me not, O LORD: O my God, be not far from me. Make haste to help me, O LORD my salvation.

<u>39:12-13</u> Hear my prayer, O LORD, and give ear unto my cry; hold not thy peace at my tears: for I am a stranger with thee, and a sojourner, as all my fathers were. O spare me, that I may recover strength, before I go hence, and be no more.

42:1 As the hart panteth after the water brooks, so panteth my soul after thee, O God.

43:3 O send out thy light and thy truth: let them lead me; let them bring me unto thy holy hill, and to thy tabernacles.

54:1-2 Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength. Hear my prayer, O God; give ear to the words of my mouth.

56:1 Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me.

57:1.4 Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast.

My soul is among lions: and I lie even among then that are set on fire, even the sons of men, whose teeth are spears and arrows, and their tongue a sharp sword.

55:1-2 Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication. Attend unto me, and hear me: I mourn in my complaint, and make a noise;

59:1 Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God: defend me from them that rise up against me. Deliver me from the workers of iniquity, and save me from bloody men.

<u>61:1-2</u> Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer. From the end of the earth will I cry unto thee, when my heart is overwhelmed: lead me to the rock that is higher than I.

63:1 O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is; To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen in the sanctuary.

<u>19:14</u> Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer.
