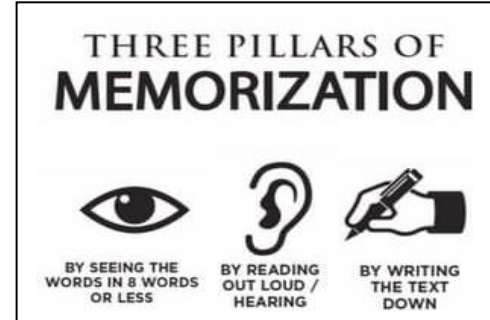


Evangelism 101- Bible Study – Wednesday 7:00pm

1 – 3rd Wed 7/20/2022

Psalms 119:105 (KJV) NUN. **“Thy word is a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.”**

Psalms 119:105 (NIV) “Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.”

Psalms 119:105 (NLT) “Your word is a lamp to guide my feet and a light for my path.”

Psalms 119:105 (NKJV) “Your word *is* a lamp to my feet And a light to my path.”

2 – 4th Wed 7/27/2022

Psalms 119:11 (KJV) **“Thy word have I hid in mine heart, that I might not sin against thee.”**

Psalms 119:11 (NIV) “I have hidden your word in my heart that I might not sin against you.”

Psalms 119:11 (NLT) “I have hidden your word in my heart, that I might not sin against you.”

Psalms 119:11 (NKJV) “Your word I have hidden in my heart, That I might not sin against You.”

3 – 1st Wed 8/3/2022

Colossians 3:16 (KJV) **“Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”**

Colossians 3:16 (NIV) “Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts.”

Colossians 3:16 (NLT) “Let the message about Christ, in all its richness, fill your lives. Teach and counsel each other with all the wisdom he gives. Sing psalms and hymns and spiritual songs to God with thankful hearts.”

Colossians 3:16 (NKJV) “Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.”

John 1:14 (KJV) “**And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.**”

John 1:14 (NIV) “The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.”

John 1:14 (NLT) “So the Word became human and made his home among us. He was full of unfailing love and faithfulness. And we have seen his glory, the glory of the Father’s one and only Son.”

John 1:14 (NKJV) “And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.”

5 – 3rd Wed 8/17/2022

1 Corinthians 3:16 (KJV) “**Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and *that* the Spirit of God dwelleth in you?**”

1 Corinthians 3:16 (NIV) “Don’t you know that you yourselves are God’s temple and that God’s Spirit dwells in your midst?”

1 Corinthians 3:16 (NLT) “Don’t you realize that all of you together are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God lives in you?”

1 Corinthians 3:16 (NKJV) “Do you not know that you are the temple of God and *that* the Spirit of God dwells in you?”

6 – 4th Wed 8/24/2022

Romans 3:23 (KJV) “**For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;**”

Romans 3:23 (NIV) “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,”

Romans 3:23 (NLT) “For everyone has sinned; we all fall short of God’s glorious standard.”

Romans 3:23 (NKJV) “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God, “

7 – 5th Wed 8/31/2022

Romans 6:23 (KJV) “**For the wages of sin *is* death; but the gift of God *is* eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.**”

Romans 6:23 (NIV) “For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Romans 6:23 (NLT) “For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of God is eternal life through Christ Jesus our Lord.”

Romans 6:23 (NKJV) “For the wages of sin *is* death, but the gift of God *is* eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.”

8 – 1st Wed 9/7/2022

Romans 5:8 (KJV) “But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us.”

Romans 5:8 (NIV) “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

Romans 5:8 (NLT) “But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners.”

Romans 5:8 (NKJV) “But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

9 – 2nd Wed 9/14/2022

1 John 1:9 (KJV) “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

1 John 1:9 (NIV) “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”

1 John 1:9 (NLT) “But if we confess our sins to him, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all wickedness.”

1 John 1:9 (NKJV) “If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.”

10 – 3rd Wed 9/21/2022

Romans 10:13 (KJV) “For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

Romans 10:13 (NIV) for, “Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.”

Romans 10:13 (NLT) For “Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved.”

Romans 10:13 (NKJV) For “whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.”

Romans 10:9-10 (KJV)

10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:9-10 (NIV)

9 If you declare with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved.

Romans 10:9-10 (NLT)

9 If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved.

10 For it is by believing in your heart that you are made right with God, and it is by openly declaring your faith that you are saved.

Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)

2 Corinthians 1:20 (NIV) For no matter how many promises God has made, they are “Yes” in Christ. And so through Him the “Amen” is spoken by us to the glory of God.

2 Corinthians 1:20 (KJV) For all the promises of God in him *are* yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us.

2 Corinthians 1:20 (NLT) For all of God’s promises have been fulfilled in Christ with a resounding “Yes!” And through Christ, our “Amen” (which means “Yes”) ascends to God for his glory.

2 Corinthians 1:20 (NKJV) For all the promises of God in Him *are* Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us.
